* MY SCHEDULED DAY TO ATTEND IS:

- * Be at the DMSC equipment garage at 0730 am and ready to go to work. The Gate will be Opened.
- * Dress for working outside, long trousers, substantial shoes, work gloves, hat, shirt and sunglasses. Check the weather forecast before making the decision as to what to wear for the day.
- * MAKE SURE YOU SIGN the ROSTER in the garage and check in with the individual in charge. Normally there is someone who is in charge and giving out work assignments for the day.
- * You may bring any personal tools but the club normally has everything that is needed. If the club runs short on anything it will be hammers, cordless drill/drivers, shovels, rakes, etc. Thank you for volunteering your personal tools.
- * In the morning we will serve coffee and donuts in the clubhouse. Bottled water will be available through out the day. We also serve lunch around noon.
- * We do everything it takes to keep the club up and running, cleaning, ditch digging, painting, mowing, weed trimming, tree trimming and removal and equipment maintenance, just to name a few things.
- * Normally we work until mid-afternoon. You need to stay until released by the person in charge.
- * Your BLUE CARD will be signed immediately just before everyone is dismissed for the day.
- * A cancellation due to weather does not happen very often. But if it does the decision will normally be made a day or two in advance. The cancellation will be posted on the DMSC club website.
- * SAFETY is our biggest goal at all Work Parties. We will not assign you any task that you are not trained on or uncomfortable in doing. Please let the person in charge know if you have any health problems.
- * If you are unable to attend YOUR SCHEDULED Work Party due to sickness, work ,a family emergency, etc., you must call Bill Fertall at 724-288-5400 as soon as possible prior to your scheduled day. You will be given another date in the future to full fill your Work Party obligation. This point of contact is ONLY to be used for WORK PARTY ISSUES.
